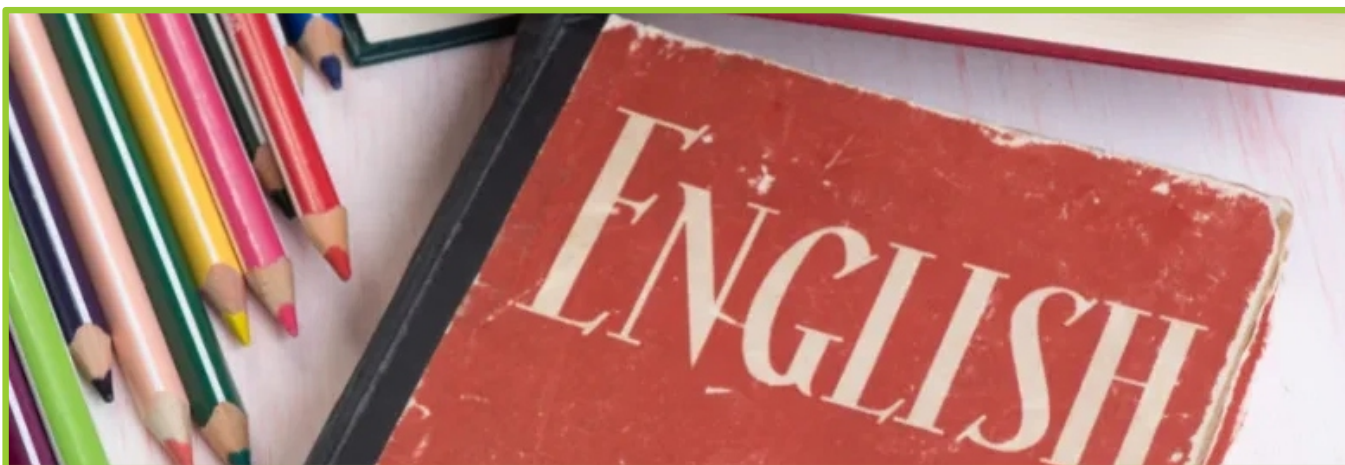

Program Objectives:

The AD English (02 Years) program is an Associate Degree program which follows the guidelines of Higher Education Commission, Islamabad, Pakistan. It helps the learner how to use various skills involved with the interpretation, understanding, analysis, reading and research of various texts and pieces of English literature. Courses are selected in order to develop an understanding of different genres and forms of literary expression (poetry, prose, novel, drama, non-fiction) as well as linguistic and rhetorical skills through frequent reading and writing assignments and class discussions.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates holding Intermediate certificate with at least 45% marks or A-Levels with equivalency certificate from IBCC Islamabad or an equivalent certificate from a recognized institution are eligible to apply.

Candidates need to pass an entry test or an aptitude interview conducted by the University.

Program Outcomes:

- ◆ The students will have the knowledge of historical traditions in literature.
- ◆ The students will understand how written and spoken language expresses diverse cultural experiences.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 4 Years:** Candidates holding Intermediate certificate with at least 45% marks or A-Levels with equivalency certificate from IBCC Islamabad or an equivalent certificate from a recognized institution are eligible to apply.
- 2.5 Years:** Candidates holding Bachelor degree (14 years of education) with at least 45% marks in annual system or AD in non relevant discipline with 2.00 CGPA on the scale of 4.00 from a recognized institution are eligible to apply. After Bridge Semester, the scheme from 5th till 8th Semester will be followed.
- 2 Years:** Candidates holding Associate Degree in relevant discipline with at least 45% marks in annual system or 2.00 CGPA on the scale of 4.00 in semester system from a recognized institution are eligible to apply. The scheme from 5th till 8th Semester will be followed.

Candidates will be required to pass an entry test or an aptitude interview conducted by the university.

Program Objectives:

The program aims at developing learners' ability to critically read and analyze linguistics and literary texts in their historical, socio political, cultural and philosophical contexts combined with aesthetic pleasure and intellectual stimulation. Emphasis is on literary expression (poetry, prose, novel, drama, non-fiction) as well as linguistic and rhetorical skills through frequent reading and writing assignments, and class discussions.
